## **Terms and Conditions of Payment and Membership**

1. A Membership Application will only be processed upon receipt of both payment and the Membership Application Form.
2. A receipt will only be sent on request
3. Invoiced payments will only be considered for membership applications of 10 or more memberships
4. Membership runs annually for 12 consecutive months starting from the date the application is processed
5. Membership is open to everyone in the travel industry – however from time to time The Guild may seek proof of industry employment or status
6. The Guild does not sell on its membership list to any third party
7. The Guild Membership card remains the property of The Guild and can be recalled by The Guild at any time it sees fit in accordance with the member's action which may be deemed to be seen as detrimental to the interests of The Guild and its members
8. The Guild Membership card is not transferable
9. Guild benefits in accordance with the category of membership are not changeable for monetary value
10. A member may upgrade their membership at any time during the membership year on payment of the membership fee differential
11. Fellowship Membership of The Guild is invited to those who have been Guild Members for three or more years and hold senior positions in the travel industry
12. A Corporate Member is the named member of a registered business in the travel industry, or travel industry supplier, with one employee or more
13. An Individual Member is a person in the travel industry, or a travel industry supplier, with no employees
